- 6. Time for Part I is 90 minutes and for Part II is 90 minutes.
- 7. Each question carries 1 (one) mark.
- 8. Write your Roll Number, as given in the Admit Card, on the answer Sheet and o the cover page of the Question Booklet in the space provided.
- 9. DO NOT write your name in any part of the Question Booklet or the Answer Sheet.
- 10. All questions in the booklets are objective type. For each question FOUR or FIVE possible answers are given, but only one is correct. Your task is to find out the correct answer and mark your choice in the Answer Sheet.
- 11. Record your answer using PEN only. You have to indicate your answer on the answer sheet as advised by the State/UT.
- 12. During the examination follow the instructions of the Invigilator strictly.
- 13. Hand over your Question Booklet and answer sheet to the invigilator before you leave the Examination hall.
- 14. Hand over the admission card to the Invigilator before leaving the Examination hall.
